Dear Mr. Daniels:

We have reviewed PMC's minor revision to their Refuse Pile Expansion
Plan. The following comments were telephoned to Sally Keefer on June
25, 1982.

1. The two detention basins for the haul road could be combined
within the roadway embankment rather than separately constructed.
This would cause less disturbance.
2. The channel to carry water from the topsoil stockpile detention
basin to the sediment pond is not shown on the plans.

We agree that this is a minor revision to the permit and does not
constitute a significant change or departure from the approved re-
fuse pile expansion plan.
