<p>7. Description: Plateau Mining Company has submitted a complete Mining and Reclamation Plan Application for their Star Point #1 and #2 mines to this Division. The Company has posted a \$2,340,000 surety bond to cover estimated reclamation costs for the mining operations (to be adjusted annually). The mine is an existing operation and the majority of surface and underground disturbances have occurred.</p> <p>The Division of Oil, Gas, & Mining has received concurrence from the Federal Office of Surface Mining and various other Utah State Agencies that this plan is in compliance with the Laws and Regulations pertaining to each agency. Consequently, UDOGM has issued a permit to continue mining operations for a period of 5 years.</p>





To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to the Utah Mined Land Reclamation Act and the Federal Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977, 30 U.S.C. 1201 et seq., the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (UDOGM) and the Office of Surface Mining (OSM) of the U.S. Department of the Interior have issued a permit to Plateau Mining Company for its application # ACT/007/006 to mine coal associated with the Starpoint Mines # 1 and 2 associated with the following lands:
