In January 1982, Bishopgate Coal Corporation was assessed civil penalties for failure to comply with statutes and regulations promulgated by the State of Utah and the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining. The penalties assessed total One Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$1,880.00)

Section 40-10-20(3), Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, mandates that civil penalties are to be paid within thirty (30) days of the assessment. Records maintained by the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining indicate that the aforementioned penalties have not been paid.

Be advised that if full payment of the penalties is not tendered by November 1, 1982, I shall schedule an Order to Show Cause before the Board of Oil, Gas and Mining. Should an Order to Show Cause be scheduled, I shall request that the Board direct appropriate sanctions and penalties be levied against Bishopgate Coal Corporation, including a moratorium on all future exploration activities.
