Dear Mr. Williams:

Pursuant to our telephone conversation of May 21, 1982, I am sending you a copy of the seed mix recommended by the Division biologists for revegetation of areas disturbed by coal exploration. The seed mix which was approved last year by the Division for use in revegetation of the exploration sites in the Scofield area is comprised entirely of introduced species. UMC 815.15(f)(1) requires that all disturbed lands shall be seeded or planted with the same seasonal variety native to the disturbed area.

The Division will not require that the seed mix which was previously approved be also able to meet these requirements. However, from this point forward, a seed mix such as that described in the regulations will be required. If a surface landowner requests that a seed mix other than the approved seed mix be used to revegetate the disturbed area, such requests should be made through the Division.

Below is the seed mix recommended for the coal exploration sites in the Scofield area.


