Dear Ms. Lindsay:

Floyd Johnson (Office of Surface Mining) and Gordon Whitney (Minerals Management Service) requested by telephone on September 20, 1982, Forest Service concurrence to allow Plateau Mining Company to enter the 160 acre lease modification area for Federal Coal Lease SL-031286. This area is located on the Manti-LaSal National Forest, Carbon County, Utah.

The Forest Service concurs with the proposed action with the following management requirements:

1. All stipulations from the Forest Service Environmental Assessment concerning the lease modification must be included in the approval.
2. The lease modification area must be included in the approved Star Point Mine hydrologic and subsidence monitoring plan.
3. All stipulations and conditions of the existing mine plan must be applied to the additional acreage of the lease modification.
4. There will be no surface disturbing activities associated with the proposed action.
