
Dear Mr. Coonrod,

Enclosed is a modification to NOV #1 of 1 (#N82-2-3-1) extending the abatement deadline 30 days until 7-6-82 as you requested on 6-29-82. Please be advised that no more time extensions can be granted past the 30 day abatement period, ending 7-6-82. This final extension may allow enough time to adequately address Area #3 of the violation.

The undisturbed drainage ditch #12 should be reconstructed as necessary to minimize erosion and prevent additional contributions of suspended solids to runoff. Several methods of sediment control may be appropriate. A direct conveyance with appropriate gradient should be constructed to minimize erosion, roughness structures, straw bales or detention basins will trap sediment, channel linings or a well established vegetative cover will minimize erosion and minimize additional contributions of sediment to runoff.

To prevent further animus toward ditch #12, please don't hesitate to call either Ken Wyatt or myself if there is any problem meeting this final abatement measure.
