Re: Modification of NOV 82-4-13-1

Dear Dave:

The modification of NOV 82-4-13-1 extended Bishopsgate Coal Corporation's time to reclaim until April 30, 1983. With efforts to faithfully fulfill our reclamation responsibilities on Drill Hole 81-5-1P we have come to some conclusions you should be informed of.

After a recent helicopter trip over the property by Scott Williams, I was informed of approximately 4-5 feet of snow accumulation still on the unclaimed site. It is apparent that feasibility for successful reclamation is limited until later in the Spring. The site is still unaccessible until snow has melted and may be unaccessible due to wet soil conditions from runoff for some time. Reclamation during wet or muddy conditions would only damage other areas and give less than satisfactory results from our efforts.

I would appreciate you taking these items into consideration for an extension of the abatement deadline until late May or early June.
