A review of the Division's files on the compliance history of your company has revealed that a pattern of violations as described in Rule UMC 843.13(b) exists for the Scofield Valley Exploration Project. The pattern exists by virtue of notices N81-4-5-2, N81-4-6-1, and C82-4-3-1, all State violations which involve erosion and sediment control. These violations were issued during the period between November 1, 1981 and November 1, 1982.

By copy of this letter to Ms. Barbara Roberts, Assistant Attorney General, I am requesting her assistance in issuing an Order to Show Cause to Bishopsgate Coal Company for consideration at the March 1983 Board of Oil, Gas and Mining Hearing. The order will direct Bishopsgate Coal Company to show cause why the Scofield Valley Exploration Project permit and right to mine under the Act should not be suspended or revoked.
