

Dear Ben:

As you will remember, on May 26, 1983, I modified the Notice of Violation 83-4-5-1 to require the submittal, to the Division, of complete and adequate plans to modify Plateau's approved MRP to either include the disturbed area runoff diversion (located south of Ditch No.9), which was the subject of the NOV, or to reclaim said diversion immediately in accordance with UMC 817.43(e). Having reviewed your plans, which were received by the Division on July 22, 1983, I found no mention of this diversion.

Since you, the operator, received the violation on April 25, 1983 and the plans required for abatement of the violation were received by the Division on July 22, 1983, you have two days left of the 90 day maximum time allowable for abatement of the NOV, in accordance with UMC 843.12(a)(2). If the Notice of Violation is not abated within the 90 day time frame a cessation order will be issued in accordance with UMC 843.12(d). In order to avoid further enforcement action, the operator must submit complete and adequate plans to the Division within two days (48 hours) from the date of receipt of this letter.
