The Division has received your letter dated May 4, 1983 which addresses plans to construct a new concrete trash bin to temporarily store scrap metal. The plans are to abate NOV 83-6-4-2, #1 of 2 issued by Barton Kale of the Division.

The plans, although marginal, will be adequate for permitting purposes as there has been a previous Division approval issued for another trash bin at this same location. The previous proposal provides sufficient detail to encompass those (items) areas which may not have been fully addressed in this submission.

Dear Mr. Kale:

To eliminate the problems we have had in the trash bin area, we are planning to construct a new concrete bin. The new bin will be utilized for scrap metal. In addition, a concrete berm will be constructed to contain the drainage in front of both the new bin and the existing bin. Refer to the attached plan for details of the new construction.

No dumping, parking of equipment or storage of materials will be allowed outside of the two bins.

Until the new bin is constructed, we have put the scrap metal trailer in the operations area where the runoff is controlled by a sediment pond.





