Dear Mr. Lauman:

The Division has reviewed your recent letter dated March 25, 1983 which addresses the Corner Canyon Fan Project and a request to continue driving the #4 entry fan return to the surface.

In consideration of the extenuating circumstances involved with the timely implementation of the project, the Division hereby grants approval for Getty Coal/Plateau Mining to proceed with the breakout of the #4 entry.

The Division has contacted the Office of Surface Mining (OSM), the U. S. Forest Service (USFS) and the Division of Wildlife Resources (DWR) to solicit their comments regarding this minor proposal. No significant issues or problems were identified or expressed by these agencies which would prohibit the approval of your request to proceed with the breakout.

We look forward to the receipt of the revised addendum for the Corner Canyon fan proposal sometime during the first week of April, 1983.
