Dear Sir:

Re our conversation, this date about 2:00 P. M., concerning an order from your office to Plateau Mining closing the only access road available to our construction site at and above our M. P. 18 to M. P. 20.4 (approximately).

You also advised me that your department has no jurisdiction over Utah Railway Company operations.

We have, at the present time, a large contingent of employees working in the area to which the above mentioned road is our only access.

I, as Superintendent of the Utah Railway Company, cannot allow such an unsafe procedure to take place. Therefore, I will have the barrier removed to insure the safety of our employees for a period of one to ten (1 - 10) days.

However, I assure you, we will replace the barrier (as your office ordered Plateau Mining) as soon as our access is considered safe.
