RE: Utah Railway Company Request for Water

Dear Dave;

As I discussed with you by phone yesterday, Utah Railway requested water from Plateau for dust suppression and compaction during their construction of the spur track and county road relocation. We appreciate your verbal approval of this request.

As I discussed with you, Utah Railway's contractor will install and maintain the pipeline from our reservoir to their pond. The map attached shows the location of the proposed pipeline.

The following stipulations have been given to Utah Railway for continued use of the water:


1. The location of the pipeline is to be approved by Ben Grimes.
2. The pipeline is to be water tight as possible, and to be inspected and monitored daily. Any breaks or leaks are to be repaired immediately and Plateau is to be notified of such as soon as possible.
3. Shut-off valves are to be installed periodically so flows can be cut off in case of leaks.
4. The pond is to be approved by all applicable Federal, State or County authorities.
5. No discharge is to be allowed from the pond.

As you can see on the map, the pond is located on BLM ground; the pipeline is the only thing on PMC permitted ground.

We feel that the foregoing stipulations will insure that no environmental harm can be done by the operation of the pipeline and pond. If, in the event of a leak or break in the line, erosion or other damage occurs, it will be taken care of immediately.
