A partial inspection was conducted at the above mentioned mine site on October 10, 1984, by Barton Kale of the Division. The inspector was accompanied by Ken Wyatt as well as later connecting with Tom Portle, and Lynn Kunzler, all of the Division. The company was represented by Ben Grimes.

The purpose of the inspection was to familiarize the inspector with the mine site and to view current issues under consideration. The Division technical staff was on hand to discuss topsoil problems at the new sediment pond area (west of the refuse pile) and at the unit train loadout area.

Due to the large expense of disturbed area at this mine site, another visit will be conducted before the end of the month.
