On June 29, 1984, Mr. Ben Grimes of Plateau Mining Company (PMC) called the Division (D. Wayne Hedberg) to request a two-week extension of time to provide a response to our May 23, 1984 letter.

The letter required PMC to perform survey analyses for the as-built sediment ponds #1, #3 and #5 at the Star Point Mines. Apparently, the company is having difficulty in getting the final survey results back from the surveyor in an expeditious manner and will not be able to meet our June 30, 1984 deadline for submission of the same.

Mr. Hedberg consulted with the assigned field inspector (David Lof) for the mine before returning Mr. Grimes' call and granting the two-week extension. For more background information, see DOGM letter dated May 23, 1984, Variance Request From Engineering Inspection Ponds #1, #3 and #5.
