RE: Treatment of Underflow from Thickener Tank Using Settling Ponds, MRP Amendment, Star Point Mines, ACT/007/006, #3, Carbon County, Utah

The Division has reviewed your plans received August 20, 1984 for the above operation. Before the plan can be approved, the following deficiencies must be addressed:


1. Submit adequate plans to revegetate all areas disturbed in association with the pond construction, including outslopes and top of dikes (if not needed for vehicular access). These plans shall identify seed mix(es), mulch(es), fertilizer(s) and methods of application (including rates) of each as required under UMC 784.13(b)(5) for both contemporaneous (UMC 817.100) and final reclamation (UMC 817.111-.117).
2. Submit a topsoil handling plan, including methods of stripping, depth, volumes, storage and protection as per UMC 817.21-.25.
3. Detailed costs of reclamation including concrete pad removal, regrading, topsoil replacement and revegetation must be submitted and the bond amended to reflect such costs. The existing surety may be amended with a rider until Plateau submits the annual revised bond next year.
