The Division has reviewed Plateau Mining Company's abatement plan for NOV N84-4-1-1 received February 24, 1984. Although the submittal does have some minor deficiencies, none were considered serious enough to warrant the need for additional information or review.

Therefore, the abatement plan is approved with the following condition: the operator must implement a concrete berm no less than four (4) inches in height (preferably more), rather than the proposed three (3) inch berm. Construction of this structure(s) must be completed by June 15, 1984.
