ACT/007/006, #4, Carbon County, Utah


This letter is forwarded in response to your October 31, 1985 phone request for a one week time extension to complete the previously approved plans (August 5, 1985) for modification of sediment pond #2 at the Star Point Mine. The Division finds the operator's justification for extension approvable and grants approval for the one week extension request. The new deadline for pond reconstruction is November 7, 1985.

For future reference the Division will require that all requests for extensions to approved deadlines be submitted in writing and received prior to the deadline date. Emergencies will be the only exception to this policy.

With regard to our conversation concerning what is required for change of corporate ownership, please refer to sections UMC 788.17-.19 of the underground coal regulations. The ownership transfer form I spoke of on the phone was for noncoal operations and not for coal mining operations.

Please call should questions remain. Thank you for keeping us informed of the ongoing operational status at the Star Point Mines.
