RE: Plateau Mining Company, Star Point Mines, ACT/007/006, #2, Carbon County, Utah

Pursuant to our conversation of June 27, 1985, the following will verify an earlier telephone conversation with Mr. Ben Grimes wherein a meeting with representatives of the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining's (DOG M) permit staff and Abandoned Mine Reclamation's (AMR) staff was requested. The general timing of that meeting was to be during the week of July 15, 1985 with a firm date resolution to be established.

Topic of discussion would be mode of reclamation in the #1 portal area. Evidently the #1 portal area consists of a pad with an average width of 80 feet and a belt down leading off the pad culminating in a shoot below the pad. On the outslope below the portal pad is a litter of junk and machinery attendant to the nonfunctioning conveyor system. Mr. Grimes sees earthmoving as the principal topic of discussion with attendant junk and clean-up a secondary issue. I will advise you as timing for this meeting is firmed.
