On page 784-17 PMC relates their intentions to disturb a large portion of their current refuse expansion test plots. This proposal has since been modified (see approval letter of March 29, 1985). The above mentioned letter asks for specific information as a condition to the approval of this portion of the operation. Since this page addresses this same area it must likewise, be amended to correspond to the March 29 letter.

UMC 817.22 Topsoil:Removal

The applicant on page 784-18 indicates that soil depths vary up to an maximum depth of 8 inches but states that only 6 inches of topsoil will actually be removed. This must be amended to demonstrate that all available topsoil materials will be removed. Supervision of such activity should also be addressed.

On page 784-19 the applicant discusses topsoil from the featherlegs type and the depth of topsoil and subsoil in this type. The applicant fails to address not segregating topsoil from subsoil in this type. Either segregation must be addressed and performed or a justification for not doing so must be provided.

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
