Dear Dr. Nielson:

The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE), Western Field Operations (WFO), has received the December 22, 1986, Plateau Mining Company's submittal of an amendment to the approved mine reclamation plan of Utah permit No. ACT/007/006-86B for the Star Point mines. This is a proposal to modify Sediment Pond #2 construction. OSMRE reviewed this submittal and has determined that it does not constitute a modification to the approved mining plan under 30 CFR 746.18. Based on the review of the submittal, OSMRE concurs with the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining's (DOGMS) decision to approve the submittal as indicated in DOGMS letter dated February 20, 1987, and the Federal permit UT-0018, dated January 21, 1982, is revised accordingly.
