Re: NPDES Permit UT 0023736 - 5 Day Non-Compliance Notice - Point 001

Dear Sir:

Water discharged from Point 001 continues to exceed our current limit for Total Dissolved Solids (TDS). We have corresponded with your office numerous times regarding this situation.

We met with Mr. Steve McNeal of the Utah State Department of Health, Bureau of Water Pollution Control to discuss renewal of our NPDES Permit. In this meeting, we discussed revising our Permit to modify the TDS requirements.

A request for such a modification has subsequently been submitted to Mr. McNeal to modify the permit under Part II of the "Intercepted Groundwater Policy For Implementation Of The Colorado River Salinity Standards Through The NPDES Permit Program".

A copy of the most recent discharge analysis is attached. As you can see, TDS at Point 001 was 1140 mg/l, which is about our limit of 650 mg/l. All other parameters are within limits.


