I reviewed the exploration amendment from Plateau for three potential drill sites. The exploration map updates and identifies the proposed drilling locations. The Division conditionally approved the plan for Exploration Permit 86-1 on June 17, 1986. This permit contained nine (9) stipulations which were adequately responded to by Plateau Mining Company. All of these conditions still apply.

It should be reiterated in the letter to Plateau Mining Company that, according to Stipulation #9 "Upon completion of the coal exploration operation, the Division requires the operator to file a completion notice with this office. The notice should include a description of the plugging and reclamation activities which have taken place for each drill site."

This proposal can be approved as the amendment to Exploration Permit 86-1.

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
