Re: Conditional Approval of PAP Amendment, "Spoil Disposal Area Plan", Cyprus-Plateau Mining Corporation, Star Point Mine, ACT/007/006-87D, Folder #3, Carbon County, Utah

The Division has completed its review of your response, dated September 15, 1987, to our request for information regarding UMC 784.11(b)(4). The information has been determined adequate for conditional approval. Please provide the information requested under the following conditions by November 30, 1987:

1. Plateau Mining Company must provide and maintain a minimum 12 inch height for runoff control berms in the spoil disposal/storage areas. This requirement must be included as part of the revised text for insertion into the approved mining and reclamation plan.
2. Plateau Mining Company must submit fourteen (14) copies of the text changes and maps for insertion into the approved Permit Application Package.
