
Please be advised that the following conditions must be satisfactorily addressed by December 13, 1986 in order to obtain final approval.

- 1) Sheet F-12 must be updated to include the true locations of both diversion 7F and the toe slope ditch and marked to indicate those reaches requiring riprap.
- 2) Exhibit 33, Volume 4 of the Starpoint Mines Permit Renewal Application (specifically Tables 2 & 3, Figure 2, and the text on page 11) must be updated to include the information contained in your submittals of October 31 and September 15, 1986.
