SUBJECT: Final Reclamation of Roads Star Point Mine Plateau Mining Company



I recently met with Mr. Bob Lauman to discuss reclamation plans for State owned lands within the Star Point Mine Complex. It is my understanding that Carbon County and the U.S. Forest Service desire that some of the roads crossing these lands permanently remain open for access to transmitter facilities located higher upon the mountain. I wish to express my preference for the route to be selected.

As you are aware there are two different routes, one to the North and one to the South. The southern route involves several switchbacks across the eastern part of section 16, T15S, R8E. I feel that this route makes an unsightly blight upon the rugged terrain and would be more difficult to maintain against erosion. I have indicated on the attached map the portion which should be reclaimed. The northern route follows natural contours of the land more closely and is largely paved through the mine area. This is the route which I prefer remain open. Any road which remains open across State land, however, must be licensed under a right-of-way permit. Mr. Stan Baker of the Division of State Lands and Forestry in Moab should be contacted regarding the issuance or maintenance of Right of Way permits in that region of the State.
