Re: Temporary Construction Waste Material Storage - Amendment Request, Plateau Mining Company, Star Point Mine, ACT/007/006, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

The storage of rock and soil at the Lion Deck switchback was noted during the May 7, 1987 partial inspection. Pursuant to this issue, the following amendment is requested.

1. All areas where construction waste is stored (technically known as "spoil") must be in a designated disposal area within the permit area.
2. These designated "spoil disposal" areas must be identified on all appropriate maps.
3. The narrative in the plan must state the type of spoil materials that will be stored, duration of storage, and the drainages for the respective areas.

These "spoil disposal area" maps and additions to the mine plan are requested by June 15, 1987.
