Re: Conditional Approval, MRP Amendment, Minor Modification to Sediment Pond #2 Construction, Plateau Mining Company, Star Point Mines, Folder #3, ACT/007/006-86B, Carbon County, Utah

The Division has completed its review of the above-referenced MRP Amendment request, which was received December 31, 1986. Division hydrologist Tom Munson has performed a technical review of the modification and finds the plan is acceptable and follows standard engineering practices. The riprap, apron size and filter blanket design have been looked at and are of adequate size to prevent erosion at the intended location. The Division hereby grants conditional approval of the proposal with the following condition. Please provide twelve (12) additional copies of the approved plan to update all appropriate regulatory mine plan permit applications on file. The plans should be appropriately labelled and formatted to allow direct into the approved permit application.

If possible, please provide the additional copies by March 14, 1987. We appreciate your patience and cooperation in completing this permitting action. Please call me or Tom Munson should you have any question or concerns regarding this approval.
