RE: **Stipulation UMC 817.44(1) Response**

Dear Mr. Braxton:

As per our commitment, we are submitting detailed maps showing final Channel Reclamation Plans. Three sets of maps are being sent under separate cover for Division review.

This submittal is the second for this stipulation; the Division has some concerns with the first submittal. On February 24, 1988 we met with Division staff and discussed their concerns. In a response to you dated April 27, 1988, I outlined our understanding of the conclusions reached at the February meeting, and no response has been received from the Division. This submittal is based on our understanding of the Division's concerns.

As you will see, channels crossed by the Lion Deck Mine access road have not been shown to be reclaimed. The Carbon County Commission wants the road to be left in place after our mining operation has ceased. We are in the process of turning the road over to the County. Cyprus-Plateau will maintain the road and all associated drainage structures until the end of our bond liability period at which time maintenance will be the responsibility of Carbon County. The only change from the present condition as far as the Division is concerned will be reclamation of the road.
