Enclosed please find 3 copies of revised text and revised table 80. This revised material is intended to clarify unclear language in our approved permit.

During a recent inspection, Bill Malencik reviewed our Ground and Surface Water Monitoring Plan and had some difficulty understanding what we actually committed to. I agreed with him that there could be misinterpretation of the approved plan. Subsequently I have attempted to clear up the confusion.

The enclosed text pages and table are intended to replace existing pages in our approved permit document to reduce the possibility of misinterpretation. In addition, the monitoring schedule for springs above Lease U-13097 on the west side of the Graben has been updated to agree with the latest mine sequence projections.

Please review this information and let me know if you have any questions with the text or table. When the Division is satisfied with this material, I will send 14 copies so that all agencies and copies of our permit document can be updated.
