Re: Forest Service Spring Review, Cyprus-Plateau Mining Company,  
Starpoint Mine, ACT/007/006, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

The Division received a letter from you on September 19, 1988, discussing the U.S. Forest Service's concerns with spring monitoring at the Starpoint Mine. On September 20, 1988, the U.S. Forest Service sent a letter to the Division discussing their field review of the springs in question, and stated that they had not yet completed their field survey.

The Division has reviewed both letters and it appears that springs 503, 5-12-1, and 440 are the only springs for which field data will be required from the U.S. Forest Service to determine if monitoring will be required. Plateau Mining Company has committed to monitoring the remaining springs in question.
