The operator has provided an annual Subsidence Monitoring Report for 1987 that discusses a visual inspection and presents vertical movement data.

Maximum measured subsidence has occurred above Longwall Panel 2 (-6.28 feet). Two short subsidence cracks approximately two inches wide developed above Longwall Panel 4. No other subsidence-induced mining impacts were identified during 1987.

The operator has complied with the approved permit.
