Dear Mr. Smith:

Ralph Rollins, Ph.D. and I met with Pamela Grubaugh-Littig on September 22 to discuss her concerns with our previous responses to Stipulation UMC 817.101-(1)-(PGL).

As a result of the meeting, we agreed to do the following:

1. Provide copies of three geotechnical investigations at the mine site covering the mine access road and the lower operations area.
2. Rollins, Brown and Gunnel, Inc., Professional Engineers (RB&G), will evaluate the old No. 1 mine area soils for stability upon reclamation. Samples of the sidecast materials from cuts will be analyzed. It was agreed that this would yield representative results of the reclamation backfill materials. Borings in the road cuts would not be representative of the backfill material because backfill materials will be brought up from below the road cut by using a trackhoe.

Dr. Rollins asked if November 15, 1989, would be acceptable to respond on this issue since samples will have to be obtained and analyzed. Pam indicated that this date would be acceptable. We are, therefore, asking that the response date be extended to November 15, 1989.
