As a result of a DWR letter to myself, dated March 6, 1989, and discussions between Rick Smith of your office and Clark Johnson with U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, an amendment to our permit is necessary.

To prevent possible disturbance to nesting eagles, it is necessary to suspend monitoring activities associated with the eagles and the cliff in Section 18. Monitoring will be resumed as per the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service's requirements.

The attached page needs to be added to Exhibit 41 of our MRP to make this modification.

In the event eagles are nesting or attempting to nest in the vicinity of monitoring activity associated with Permit PRT-719890, and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service determines that monitoring activity may cause stress or nesting activity abandonment, CPMC will suspend monitoring as per U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service requirements.

Monitoring will be resumed on a schedule and timing basis as determined by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and the Utah Division of Wildlife Resources.

All other requirements of the permit remain in effect and will be conducted according to schedule.
