Re: Water Monitoring Plan and Revised Parameters List

Enclosed, please find revised text pages, and revised Table 80 incorporating the approved water monitoring schedule. This approved schedule was discussed in your letter dated July 19, 1990.

Table 80 has been revised to reflect three changes:

- 1- Station 85-35-1 was previously shown as a well because Huntington City was contemplating adding this source into their culinary system. The water source has stopped flowing from the well casing, and is now emerging in the stream channel 100 feet south of the well. The water quality from the well never cleared up as anticipated, so it is doubtful that Huntington would ever have used the well anyway.

This station will continue to be monitored on a reduced schedule. The quality is different than the Huntington wells (station 86-35-2-3) down gradient a few hundred feet. We will continue to monitor 85-35-1 to document any changes that may occur from mining Lease U-13097.


- 2- Well 86-18-2 was lost due to mining in 1989, and therefore is of no further value. The well has been removed from the table.
- 3- Well 86-26-4 has been lost to siltation; the last reading was obtained in 1987. This well was completed in a shallow perched aquifer. Well 86-26-6, which was completed in the Spring Canyon Sandstone below the coal seam to be mined to the north will continue to be monitored, and should indicate any impacts from mining if they occur. Well 86-26-4 has been removed from the table.
