Re: Water Monitoring Plan and Revised Parameters List

Thank you for the approval on the parameters list change, however, the requirement to monitor new sources for two years is unnecessary.

The data and statistical analyses presented previously prove that no significant quantities of the parameters exist anywhere in the area to justify baseline monitoring for two years. Data from the springs, and streams from the entire area is very similar in quality. The Division has not shown that a valid reason exists for two years of baseline data using the extended parameters list.

CPMC proposes that new sources be monitored one time for the extended parameters list. If levels of the parameters indicates a significant deviation from other known waters in the area, the extended parameters list will be continued for one year, at which time, further evaluations will document the need for a different monitoring schedule.
