Synopsis

The operator submitted formal plans and parameter lists for the revised monitoring plan discussing frequency and schedules for the years 1990 and 1991. This memo reviews this request.

Analysis

The plan divides surface water, ground water, and mine flow into baseline and operational monitoring. The operator has provided adequate justification for revising his parameter list and has done a good job providing clear sampling plans and parameter lists.

If the mine plan changes for Gentry Ridge, as discussed with Mr. Ben Grimes, Springs 444, S14-9, 429, and 749 will come on line sooner than expected and the appropriate changes will be made in the monitoring plans.

Recommendation

This monitoring plan be approved and inserted into the PAP.

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
