**Re: Minor Modification - Add Anti Freeze Structure**

Please find enclosed 8 copies of page 2 of Table 67 and Map No 44, Sheet F-12 showing the addition of a concrete structure 40 ft X 20 ft to contain two 6,000 gallon anti freeze tanks owned by Intermountain Power, and Nevada Power.

The tanks and plumbing will remain the property of the two customers, the concrete structure will be constructed by Cyprus Plateau Mining Corporation. The concrete structure will consist of a concrete slab with 2'3" high walls around the perimeter. The structure is to contain any anti freeze that may leak from the tanks, or to contain the anti freeze if a tank ruptures.

Construction of the concrete structure needs to start as soon as possible.

The structure will be very near the silo, therefore demolition at reclamation time will be taken care of during the silo demolition. No additional costs will be required to be added to the reclamation bond.
