Dear Mr. Rogers:

Cyprus Plateau's 1992 exploration plan on Federal coal lease U-64263, drill holes PP-10-1 and PP-10-3, is approved as submitted, subject to the following conditions:

1. All drill holes will be properly sealed in accordance with the enclosed Bureau of Land Management drilling stipulations.
2. All enclosed Forest Service special stipulations will be followed.
3. The project cannot be implemented prior to October 6, 1992.
4. An agreement must be reached with the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service regarding any depletions of water (water used for drilling) from the Colorado River Drainage System, and prior depletion fees must be paid. This must be accomplished before any work begins.
5. The present lease bond is \$617,440. We will require that the lease bond be increased to \$641,440. The \$24,000 increase in the bond will cover plugging procedures and final abandonment (\$20,000), and the reclamation (\$4,000). This project cannot be implemented until a bond is in place.
