Re: Underground Storage Tank Removal - Division Letter 2/10/92

This letter serves notice to the Division that the diesel tank removal project is proceeding as required by the Utah Division of Environmental Response and Remediation. The excavation is being backfilled with soil material and not with refuse material.

We would like to clarify a couple of items mentioned in Henry Sauer's memo of February 6. While it is true that Exhibit 528.322b, Figure 7 final topographic contours do not agree with the currently approved Post-Disturbance Topography as shown on Map 542.200c, the area of the diesel tank removal is within the refuse pile area as shown on Exhibit 528.322b, Figures 5 and 7, Map 542.200c, Post-Disturbance Topography, and Map 521.121c, Surface Facilities. Exhibit 528.322b is an extension plan and feasibility study made in 1981 to expand the size of the refuse pile. Since 1981, the refuse pile construction plan has been revised and approved by the Division; the current Maps 542.200c and 521.121c reflect the approved refuse pile boundary limits and as such constitute the refuse pile. The diesel tank removal project area is within the approved refuse pile area.

Because of concerns of the Division, we are backfilling the excavation with soil material at an added expense to Plateau to alleviate any questions.
