## SYNOPSIS

The Division received this amendment on September 11, 1992. In the amendment, the permittee proposes to replace the watchman's trailer with a weather station. The weather station will consist of a concrete pad, a rain gauge, and a 30-foot aluminum tower. The watchman's trailer and the concrete pad upon which it rests will be removed. The trailer is Item 22 on the surface facilities map and the weather station will take its place and remain Item 22.

## ANALYSIS

The watchman's trailer has been redesignated as a weather station, Item 22 in Table 526.111a, page 500-33. It is also shown on Map 521.121c, 'Surface Facilities'. As the weather station will simply take the place of the watchman's trailer, there will be no change in the sediment control plan. There will also be no change in the reclamation bond, since the weather station will consist of 20 cubic feet of material, as opposed to the 3,840 cubic feet of material in the watchman's trailer.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that this amendment be approved and included as part of the plan and that construction of the weather station be allowed to begin.
