SYNOPSIS

The operator has responded (received July 8, 1992) to my July 1, 1992 deficiency memo. The commitments made by the operator to determine the acid- and/or toxic-forming and alkalinity producing potential of the roof, floor and midseam material on the west side of the Bear Canyon Graben are adequate to resolve the deficiencies noted.

The aforementioned material will be analyzed for the following constituents: Texture; Saturation Percent; pH; Electrical Conductivity; Soluble Ca, Mg, and Na; SAR; Boron; Selenium; Total Sulfur; Neutralization Potential; and Acid Base Potential. Sample site locations are depicted on Map 116.100c.
