Re: Variance Request for Ditches 51, 57, and 58 Denied, Cyprus Plateau Mining Corporation, Star Point Mine, ACT/007/006-92F, Folder #3, Carbon County, Utah

The request for a variance from meeting the design requirements for Ditches 51, 57, and 58 (letter received May 6, 1992), is denied. The design specification of R645-301-742.333 requires that a 10-year/6-hour precipitation event be used to size the diversions versus the original designs which used the 10-year/24-hour precipitation event. The current precipitation event criteria significantly reduces the size of the ditches.

Please resubmit the designs for these ditches to demonstrate compliance with applicable rules R645-301-742.300 through R645-301-742.333. Please resubmit this information by July 9, 1992.
