Dear Ms. Grubaugh-Littig,

I am writing this letter to communicate to you Cyprus Plateau's response to the letters we recently received from Bill Malencik and yourself. We appreciate the concerns Mr. Malencik has pointed out and I will explain how we will address them.

First, there have been several changes in management at our mine. John Borla has been appointed Manager of Technical Services. John has been our Manager of Surface Operations will continue to oversee the surface operations. However, more responsibility for the surface operations, including the maintenance of the environmental control system, will fall on the Surface Foremen. The Surface Foremen have been assigned to escort all inspectors during inspections of their area of responsibility. We feel this will accomplish two goals. The first being education of the Surface Foremen on the regulations and requirements of our mining permit. Secondly, this will create better communication between the people doing the work and the inspector.

Secondly, the work schedule for the surface crews has been changed from 5 days per week coverage to 7 days per week coverage. This will provide 2 additional days per week in which maintenance work can be done on the environmental control system.

In addition to the above mentioned changes, two college students will soon be hired to work with the surface crews during the summer months. They will work strictly day shift and their primary responsibility will be to assist on the maintenance of the environmental control system.

I have personally discussed the importance of environmental compliance with John Borla and his Surface Foremen. They have assured me that they will work to keep the property within compliance and be very responsive to your inspectors suggestions. John will also meet with Mr. Malencik to discuss these changes.
