Thank you for your call regarding the Cyprus-Amax merger. As I indicated in our conversation, the Division's programmatic requirements must be addressed for the AVS (Applicant Violator System) information and be included in the permit application packages for the Starpoint and Castlegate permits. Sharon Featherhuff of your company has indicated to me that the AVS requirements for this exercise have been completed by submission of requisite information to Kim Foster of the AVS office in Lexington, Kentucky. This information must be reflected in the Starpoint and Castlegate permit application packages.

To date, the Division is in receipt of your letter to Lowell Braxton dated January 26, 1994, depicting a portion of the ownership and control information for the Starpoint and Castlegate Mines that was submitted to the AVS office. As stated before, this AVS information must be submitted to the Division for inclusion in the permit application package for the Starpoint and Castlegate Mine permits pursuant to R645-301-110.

Please submit this information to the Division by February 25, 1994. Thank you for your participation in this ongoing process.
