The Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (Division) has reviewed the proposed Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) for the Castle Valley Ridge Federal Lease Addition (UTU-64263) and determined the MRP to be administratively complete. In compliance with Section R645-300-121.300 of the Utah Coal Mining Reclamation Act (UCA Section 40-10-1 et seq.), notice is hereby given to all appropriate agencies having a jurisdiction over or an interest in the area of the operations that a complete plan is available for public review.

Cyprus Plateau Mining Corporation (CPMC) is proposing to mine approximately 2000 acres in Federal Lease UTU-64263 at the Star Point Mine.

The permit area is located in Carbon County, Utah. The following areas comprise the permit area for the Castle Valley Ridge Lease Tract.

The Division of Oil, Gas and Mining will now prepare a Technical Analysis (TA) to determine whether the plan meets all the criteria of the Permanent Performance Program Standards according to the requirements of UCA, Section 40-10-1 et seq.
