General Comments. The permittee requested a courtsey inspection. The reason for the request was associated with a new hire, John Pappas as the Starpoint environmental coordinator.

The courtsey inspection, not totally completed, will cover the entire mine site with the exception of the area covered by this permit.

Partial Inspection: Was advised by Pam that the MRP associated to AVS corporate structure - names - titles etc. needs to be updated as an MRP update. In turn, this information will then be used by OSM based on DORM submission to update the AVS system. Since DORM policy requires a 4th quarter AVS check (April-June) the permittee should complete this project by the end of March.

Signs & Markers Signs and markers were observed in the Dilo area. Some disturbed markers appear to have been placed beyond the disturbed area. It's not a big problem, but upon reclamation it might be. Pointed this out to Mr. Pappas for his evaluation and followup as may be necessary.

Sediment Ponds. Observed ponds 6, 5, 9 & 8. Pond 8 was discharging and samples were taken on 3/2/95

Return Pile. Need to reevaluate the drainage on the northeast toe of the refuse pile where it interfaces with the seal pits.

Diversion. Conditions are suitable for selective maintenance on some diversions, whereas on other diversions conditions are saturated. In the latter situation things will have to dry out before maintenance work can be performed effectively.

Diversion, primary road was being cleaned during the inspection. The diversion is located by the lower office.
