## SUMMARY

The Division received plans from Plateau Mining Company on August 3, 1999 in response to the Division Order of July 6, 1999. CMP is required to update the Probable Hydrologic Consequences (PHC) and related MRP sections with the information identifying the existence and hydrologic impacts and of the longwall mining equipment to be left underground.

## Analysis

The submitted information is formatted for the MRP, which includes impacts to hydrologic conditions from mining. The information identifies the existence of the longwall mining equipment to be left underground at Panel 42. The submittal contains reports submitted by Hansen, Allen and Luce, consulting firm and Joy Mining Machinery Corporation which concluded that there is a low probability of long term impacts to the hydrologic regime.

## Findings

This Division Order response is recommended for approval.
