Dear Mr. Hawkes:

Discharge Monitoring Reports are enclosed for the month of October. Reclamation activities through outfall 004 (pond 4) were performed in October as the reclamation of the Star Point Mine progressed down the canyon.

To date, outfalls 2 and 4 have been removed as part of the Star Point Mine reclamation. Weather permitting outfalls 007 and 009 will be reclaimed during this reclamation season.

On October 7, outfall 004 was observed discharging at a rate of 8.6 gpm. A sample was taken for analysis. On October 15, the results were faxed to me showing the effluent total suspended solids at 117 ppm which is in excess of the maximum daily allowance. The total dissolved solids were 1069 ppm which reflects a loading of only 110 lbs per day.
