David,

This email is in response to your email concerning missing parameters for the Star Point water monitoring site ST-1.

After our discussions on this subject last March (see your email of March 15, 2006) the only missing data for the 2nd and 3rd quarters of 2005 was Total Manganese. Although we were never sure why SGS Minerals dropped the testing for Total Manganese and switched to Dissolved Manganese I corrected the problem by having both Total and Dissolved Manganese tested for all future samples in order to make sure the problem did not happen again.

Now, according to your email of June 30, 2006 we are missing many parameters for the same water samples that were only missing Total Manganese in March. Based on my review excel file you sent to me, the data is not missing at all but is showing up in the wrong place on the report. For example, in the report attached to your March 15, 2006 email you show that we correctly reported Dissolved Calcium for the second quarter 2006 as 163 but in the report attached to your email of June 30, 2006 you show that we did not report Dissolved Calcium for the second quarter 2006. This latest report shows the value for Dissolved Calcium (163) in the column for Bicarbonate and the correct data for the Bicarbonate has moved from the Bicarbonate column to the column with a heading of T-P, etc. etc. etc..

Please correct the problems with your report and let me know if any problems still exist.
